Faculty of Theology

The Faculty of Theology (FOT), formerly known as Nazarene College of Theology (NCT), is the oldest theological training institution of the Church of the Nazarene in Africa. Its primary function has been and continues to be the preparation of persons for the Christian ministry. NCT is the direct result of the Church of the Nazarene missionary efforts in Africa by the Rev. H. Schmelzenbach. This work was begun in the northwest part of the Kingdom of Swaziland in 1910. From 1912 until 1931 the college was situated in then orthwestern part of the country and in 1935 the campus was moved to a four-hundred-acre site in Siteki in the eastern part of the Kingdom on the Lubombo Mountain range.

Diploma in Business Management (Dip.BME).

Overview of the programme

The Department of Business Management & Entrepreneurship currently offers a diploma in Business Management and Entrepreneurship. The BME is designed to equip graduates with skills to start and manage their own business ventures which can be profit making social enterprises. Graduates of the programme can also join the world of employment in junior positions in in finance/accounting, marketing and general management of small business in the career field.

Duration

This is a three (3) year programme designed to equip students, with practical business and entrepreneurship skills.

Admission requirements

- Minimum 4 credits (C-grade or better) & 2 passes (English, Mathematics and two commercial subjects)

OR

- any business qualification at certificate level from a recognized institution.

- Start and successfully run your own business
- Be employed in any business arears like accounts, finance marketing and etc.

DEPARTMENT OF THEOLOGY

Bachelor of Theology

Overview of the Programme

The program aims to produce competent theologians who embody character and integrity; who will be prepared to meet the challenges of their time and make a positive difference in their communities. It tackles advanced theoretical and research aspects in theology and the biblical truth, and prepares ministers for service in the church by equipping them intellectually, socially and spiritually.

Campus

- Siteki

Admission Requirements

- Six (6) credit passes (C-grade or better)
- Mature age entry - candidates must be above 25 years, have attended and completed a course of study in the last 10 years at an institution recognized by the university.

Duration

The programme is studied over a four (4) year period or 8 semesters, on flexible evening classes.

Diploma in Theology

Overview of the Programme

The program is designed to enrich students' understanding of theological and biblical truth and affords them ability to effectively communicate the gospel truth with confidence and integrity. It also enables them to lead, teach, counsel, and preach with understanding the gospel of Jesus Christ. Lastly, it prepares students to face the challenge of theological debate and proper exegesis.

Admission Requirements

- A minimum of three (3) GCE/IGCSE/SGCSE passes at C grade or better in any three subjects including English.
- The applicant must be at least eighteen (18) years with two or more years of active involvement in a local church.

Duration

The programme is studied over a three (3) year period or six (6) semesters on flexible evening classes.

CERTIFICATE IN PASTORAL MINISTRY (CPM)

Overview of the Programme

This programme will acquaint aspiring Ministers of the word with the foundations of Pastoral Ministry to nurture Christian maturity, ethical conduct and rich interpersonal

relationships. Throughout their studies, students will develop presentation skills by engaging in oral and written communication. During practicum, they will be exposed to various pastoral skills. The programme is offered in both the SiSwati and English languages.

Admission Requirements

This programme is designed for Saints who have not been able to complete formal high school education but do feel and want to respond to the calling to ministry.

An applicant must:

- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age and have a desire to study the Bible and Pastoral Ministry.
- Be able to read and write English/SiSwati.
- Be in good mental health.
- Obtain references from the pastor of the church which holds their membership, the committee/board of the local church, the employer or head of last school attended and a personal recommendation.

Duration

The minimum duration for this programme is three (3) years of study on a full-time basis.

Career & Advancement Opportunities in Theology

After successfully completing studies, a graduate can;

- Be a Minister (Pastor, Preacher, Reverend, etc.),
- Be a Missionary,

- Be a Counselor – Individuals, Couples
- Do Youth & Children Work/Ministry and many more.
- Also advance academically to pursue a higher level qualification

Faculty of Education

The Faculty of Education was established in 1939 as the Nazarene Teacher Training College. In 2010 when SANU was established it was merged with the other colleges of the Church of the Nazarene and renamed to Faculty of Education. The Faculty is based in the Manzini Campus. Below are the programmes offered by the Faculty.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT OF INCLUSIVE EDUCATION (BEeLMIE) PRIMARY

Overview of the Programme

The BEeLMIE is a programme of study intended for Principals and Deputy Principals or prospective leaders who wish to embrace children with special needs as they lead schools. This programme seeks to produce administrators, competent in understanding special needs in the special and mainstream schools as well as understanding school finances.

- Primary Teachers Diploma (PTD)

Duration

This is a three (3) year programme of study delivered through a mixed mode, i.e. part-time and block. Part-time lectures run on Saturdays and block lectures run during the week when schools are closed.

- Special needs Specialist for different organizations.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN SPECIAL & INCLUSIVE EDUCATION (BEeSIE) PRIMARY

Overview of the Programme

The BEeSIE programme raises awareness of special needs in learners and gives introductory scientific knowledge and skills on how to teach learners with different needs in the classroom. It seeks to produce teachers highly competent in all impairments.

Duration

This is a three (3) year programme of study delivered through a mixed mode, i.e. part-time and block. Part-time lectures run on Saturdays and block lectures run during the week when schools are closed.

- Special needs Specialist for different organizations.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN FRENCH (BED IN FRENCH) PRIMARY

Overview of the programme

The BEd French program equips French teachers with linguistic, pedagogical skills, and professional practices required to perform their tasks effectively in the classroom, school, and wider community in the digital era.

Admission Requirements

- Primary Teachers Diploma (PTD) with French as a specialization.
- A minimum of A2 level with linguistics, pedagogical skills, awarded by the French Ministry of Education to DELF/DALF as prove of the French language skills of a non – French speaking candidate.

Duration

- This is a three (3) year programme of study delivered through a mixed mode, i.e. part-time and block run.
- Part – time lectures run on Saturdays and block run during the week when schools are closed.

Career opportunities

Teacher in private and public primary schools and high schools.

PRIMARY TEACHERS' DIPLOMA (PTD)

Overview of the Programme

The Primary Teacher's Diploma programme is intended to give prospective primary school teachers the required competence in pedagogy, subject matter and supervised

teaching practice to equip graduates for the teaching profession.

Admission Requirements

- A minimum of six passes at SGCSE (or any other recognized school leaver's certificate) including English language, four (4) of which must be credit passes (C-grade or better), consisting of the following core subjects: Mathematics, Additional Mathematics, SiSwati, History, Geography, Physics Chemistry, Physical Science, combined science, integrated science biology, Human and social Biology, Home Economics, Food and Nutrition, Fashion and Fabrics, Agriculture, Religious Education, English Literature, Economics, Statistics, French, Design and Technology, or equivalent subject areas in Matric or any other equivalent School Leaver's Certificate.
- Subjects such as Bookkeeping, Accounts and Commerce will be acceptable as credits but shall not be considered as core subject credit, as they are not in the primary school curriculum currently.
- Subjects credited should fit into the following combinations for specialization in the third year:
 - a) Mathematics & Science or Agriculture or Consumer Sciences
 - b) Consumer Sciences & Science
 - c) Social Studies & Religious Education
 - d) English & SiSwati

Duration

The PTD is a three (3) year programme, studied, on a full-time basis.

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE & DEVELOPMENT DIPLOMA (FOUNDATION PHASE) – ECCD FP

Overview of the Programme

The ECCD is designed to equip graduates with skills and competencies required in nurturing the growth and development of young children from the time they are born to the age of 6. It provides an introduction to the physical, social, emotional, and intellectual development of children and appropriate practices in working with them. It is ideal for students looking for a rewarding career in the field of child care.

Admission Requirements

- A minimum of six passes at SGCSE (or any other recognized school leaver's certificate) including English language, four (4) of which must be credit passes (C-grade or better), consisting of the following core subjects: Mathematics, Additional Mathematics, SiSwati, History, Geography, Physics Chemistry, Physical Science, combined science, integrated science biology, Human and social Biology, Home Economics, Food and Nutrition, Fashion and Fabrics, Agriculture, Religious Education, English Literature, Economics, Statistics, French, Design and Technology,

or equivalent subject areas in Matric or any other equivalent School Leaver's Certificate.

- Subjects such as Bookkeeping, Accounts and Commerce will be acceptable as credits but shall not be considered as core subject credit, as they are not in the primary school curriculum currently.

Duration

The ECCD will be studied over a period of three (3) years, on a full-time basis.

Faculty of Health Sciences

The Faculty of Health Sciences (then Nazarene College of Nursing) traces its heritage to the Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital founded by Dr David Hynd, the first superintendent in 1927. Training of nurses in Swaziland began at the Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital in 1928. In 1956, a building of the Nazarene College of Nursing was constructed. This college was also merged with the other colleges of the Church of the Nazarene in 2010 when SANU was established and was renamed to Faculty of Health Sciences. The Faculty is in

the Manzini Campus and offers the programmes below.

DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY

Overview of the Programme

This programme is designed to give students a firm foundation in the areas of pharmaceutical sciences such as pharmacology, patient care and drug delivery systems and many more. Students will be trained to analyze problems and think of creative solutions through hands-on training, case studies and projects.

- Minimum of 5 credits (C-grade or better) & a pass (English, Maths & 2 sciences)
 - Cut-off points: 32
- OR**
- Certificate in Pharmacy

Duration

The programme is studied over a three (3) year period or 6 semesters, on a fulltime basis

BACHELOR OF PHARMACY

Overview of the programme

This programme is designed to prepare competent, self-directed, Christ – like pharmacists to provide holistic care and quality health services in urban, semi – urban and rural communities.

- A minimum of six (6) credits (C-grade or better), including English, Maths, and 2 sciences
 - Cut-off points: 36
- OR**
- A diploma in Pharmacy

Duration

- This programme is studied over a four (4) year period or eight (8) semesters on a full time basis.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING & MIDWIFERY

Overview of the Programme

This programme is designed to prepare competent, self-directed, Christ-like nurses and midwives to provide holistic care and quality health services in urban, semi-urban and rural communities.

Admission Requirements

- Minimum 6 credits (C-grade or better) including English, Mathematics, Biology/Life Sciences, Physics/Chemistry and any other 2 best subjects.
 - Cut-off points: 38
- OR**
- Diploma in General Nursing

Duration

This programme is studied over a four (4) year period or eight (8) semesters on a full-time basis.

- Registered Nurse in public or private health care facilities
- Lecturer/Researcher
- Advance to a Masters in Nursing

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES

Overview of the Programme

This programme is designed to prepare Laboratory professionals to proficiently conduct testing in clinical laboratory. Its main focus is on development of competencies, professional attributes, ethical & compassionate, and Managerial skills.

Admission Requirements

- Minimum 6 credits (C-grade or better) including English, Mathematics, Biology/Life Sciences, Physics/Chemistry and any other 2 best subjects.
- Cut-off points: 36

OR

- Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences

Duration

This degree is studied over a period of four (4) years or 8 semesters on a full-time basis.

- Medical laboratory Scientists
- Advance to a Masters in Medical Laboratory

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING ANAESTHESIA

Overview of the Programme

This programme is designed to equip students with advanced Anesthesia knowledge, skills and competencies to provide high quality Anesthesia services in public and private facilities.

Admission Requirements

- Diploma in general nursing or a Post Graduate Certificate in Midwifery Nursing Sciences or an equivalent
- Two years working experience.

Duration

This programme is done over a period of two (2) years or four (4) semesters on a full-time basis.

Registered Nurse Anesthetists in public and private health care facilities.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

Overview of the programme

The MScN Programme is designed to develop outstanding nurse educators and nurse leaders & managers who can contribute to and promote high quality nursing practice, education and leadership in the Kingdom of Eswatini and beyond.

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Midwifery and/or;
- Equivalent qualification in nursing that is deemed relevant by the Faculty

- Minimum 2 years nursing practice experience at the nursing degree level (post-graduation)

Duration

The programme is studied over a Two (2) Year period or 4 Semesters, full time. over

Career Opportunities

Application Fee
